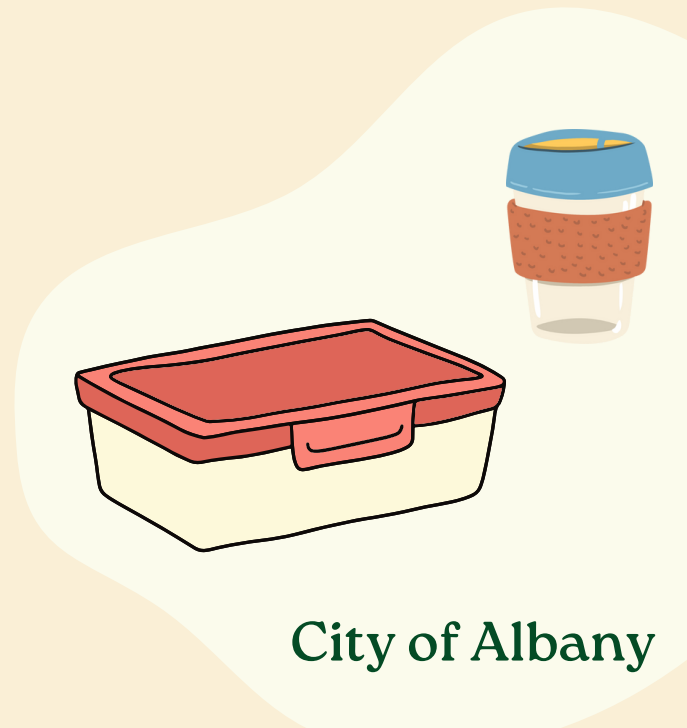

Why Reusables?

Background

Single-use plastic poses a major environmental and health concern for our community. Disposable foodware makes up roughly 60 metric tons of waster per year in Albany, and contributes to harmful carbon emissions.

Upcoming Policies

- **SB54:** Plastic Pollution Prevention and Packaging Producer Responsibility Act
- **AB1200:** Bans plastics containing PFA's

By adopting a Reusable To-Go program, restaurants can reduce waste, experience cost-savings and promote sustainability for customers.

Current Incentive Opportunities

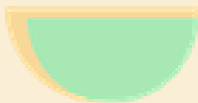
Incentives for businesses from StopWaste:

- Offering **\$1,000 in free services** to the first 25 businesses that join **DeliverZero**.



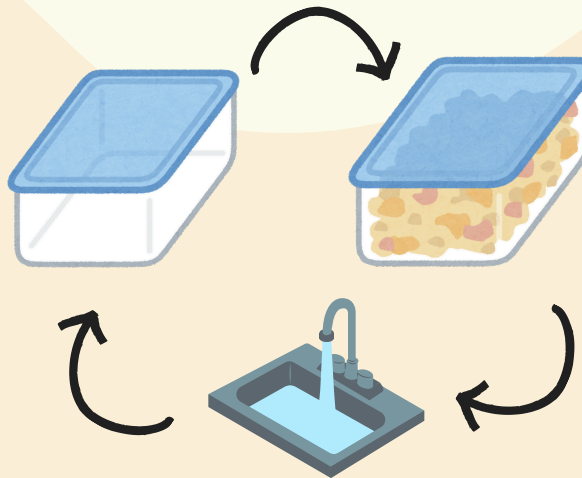
- Offering **6 months (in some cases even more) in free services** to the first few businesses that sign up for **Foodware**.

How it works!

Vendors provide dishware, inventory management, collection and washing of used dishes as well as redistribution of clean foodware for take-out and delivery. Restaurants and customers either pay an upfront fee or on a per-use basis.
